GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Collect Items

We are asking for cleaning & laundry products for our shelter families, HUB clients, or for families entering their own permanent housing units. Items for the kits are listed below but are a suggestion only. Please remember – the items listed are the most needed for our families:

- Broom/Dustpan
- Mop/Bucket
- Paper Towels
- Laundry Detergent
- All-Purpose Cleaner
- Bleach
- Disinfectant Cleaner
- Duster
- Dish Soap
- Sponges
- Kitchen Trash Bags
- Kitchen Trash Cans
- Lysol/Disinfectant Wipes

Create Kits

Now you are ready to assemble! Host an ‘assembling event’ with friends and/or coworkers or do it at home with your children. Encourage donations as well! Remember to pack the items in a sturdy container, we recommend using plastic bucket or tote that the family can use.

DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS:

Once your cleaning & laundry care kit(s) has been completed you are ready to drop them off.

Drop off location: The HUB of Hope 611 S. Ford Ave, Fullerton CA 92832

Days and Times: Tuesday through Friday between 9:30-11:30am. If you need an afternoon time, we can accept donations at 4 pm.

These are the drop off times that have been created for the safety of our staff and volunteers to maintain social distancing. Please park and knock on the right blue door and a volunteer or staff member will collect the masks. You will not enter the building.
