ABOUT THIS REMOTE PROJECT:

Volunteers are needed to create and provide family welcome kits as **Remote Volunteers**. The welcome kits you make and donate will be distributed to the families living in Pathways of Hope's shelters or families picking up food at our food distribution center. We currently have 60 people living in our shelters, and up to 50 individuals visiting the HUB in a day. As you can see, we assist a lot of people. This project can be a family project. - Full Sheets

- Pillows
- Pillowcases
- Twin Bed Bug Covers
- Full Bed Bug Covers
- Bath Towels
- Wash Cloths
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Body Wash/Soap
- Toilet Paper
- Pots/Pans
- Tupperware Containers
- Broom/Dustpan
- Mop
- Cleaning Supplies
 - Paper Towels
 - Towels
 - All-Purpose Cleaner
 - Bleach
 - Disinfectant cleaner

Create Care Kits

Now you are ready to assemble! We recommend packing the items in a sturdy container like a plastic container with a lid or a basket.
